

From the Rector ...

May I offer **my very sincere gratitude** to all of you who have spent time and energy in the church and at the rectory in preparation for my arrival here. The service of Institution was very meaningful for me, and I certainly recognised the amount of effort put into preparing the orders of service, arranging the music, cleaning the church, arranging the flowers, preparing the refreshments, and so many other things that go on in the background for such as a service of worship. Your enthusiasm in making me feel welcome and at home is deeply appreciated, and I am looking forward immensely to not only serving you as your Rector, but also becoming your friend and fellow-worker in God's Kingdom.

In addition to **visiting** the sick and housebound, I intend to visit all parishioners in our parish register in alphabetical order. The purpose of such visiting is threefold: (1) to give us the opportunity to get to know each other on a one-to-one basis, (2) to enable you to share with me in confidence any personal matters that are weighing heavily on your mind, and (3) to find some comfort and encouragement through prayer and the reading of a relevant passage of Scripture. If there is a particular reason for me to call with you sooner rather than later, then please contact me to arrange a time. Otherwise expect me to turn up unannounced on your doorstep when you least expect it! I should point out – lest I offend anyone – that I do drink plenty of tea, but would prefer not to eat any biscuits, cake, sandwiches or indeed anything else during a visit.

In my experience many people choose not to tell the clergy when they are **sick** or in **hospital**, perhaps out of a well-meaning desire not to bother us! Please be assured that it is my role as your Rector to be with you as you go through serious illness, particularly if you are admitted to hospital. In all cases, please do contact me yourself or have a relative do so, in order that I can arrange to make regular visits.

In addition to our regular service at 10:30am on Wednesdays, I intend to celebrate **Holy Communion on Holy Days** which fall on a weekday, also at 10:30am. During the coming two months, we will celebrate St Thomas (Wednesday 3rd July), St Mary Magdalene (Monday 22nd July), and the Transfiguration (Tuesday 6th August). Wednesday services will continue to use the modern-language form of Communion, whilst those services on other weekdays will use the traditional-language liturgy (Form One BCP). Please make an effort to join with the worldwide Church on these days in

commemorating the people and events which have shaped our Christian heritage.

Please note that my regular day off will be **Saturday**. Quite unlike the common perception that clergy only work Sundays, we do in fact work six days a week and therefore it is vital that we have our own day-of-rest to spend quality time with our friends and family. I would appreciate it therefore if you only contacted me on Saturdays in the case of serious pastoral emergencies.

Feel free to use the site as an online notice board. You may post any information or photos relating to events in the church or the local community which you think our parishioners would be interested in.

May I say in conclusion that I am deeply honoured to have become the **third rector of the United Parish** of St Peter & St James, making me the seventh rector of St Peter's and the eleventh rector of St James! These sorts of numbers interest me as I love to learn about the past, and you will certainly find me intrigued by any personal stories that you might have concerning the history of this parish. As well as looking backward, however, this is also a time to start looking forward! My incumbency here marks a new beginning for all of us, affording us the opportunity to rededicate both our lives and this parish to the love and service of our Lord Jesus. Please avail of this fresh start, to make a new commitment of faith, and to become regular in your church attendance, in your personal devotions, in your giving, and in your obedience to the Lord's commandments of love and forgiveness.


